- A garden at its heart




The Linear Garden

- The main movement spine

- Framed by 2 boulevards of trees
- Overlooked and contained by houses and apartments
- Changing character along its length
- Productive and beautiful







The Urban-edge Clusters

- Design to encourage community
- Higher density
- Parking integrated and adaptable for future reduction of car use









The Rural-edge Clusters

- Transition into the countryside
- Lower density
- Parking out of sight down sides of houses
- Potential for view out to countryside and access






The Micro Clusters

- Small car-free spaces
- Parking at cluster entrances
- Located at lowest parts of site and integrates drainage features into the landscape





The Linear Clusters


- Higher density short terraces
- Views and possible links to Greenway
- Parking integrated into landscaping

Garden Room; to-grow


Homes need to be more flexible to meet today's needs. Each Gardenia house will have a self-contained garden room that could be:


